ACADEMIC WRITING COURSE

One of FAAPI's statutory aims is professional development. Having this in mind, we applied for the Hornby Scholarship and we were awarded it. Isn't that great news? So we decided to launch FAAPI 's platform and carry out one of our most precious projects, an online seminar called **"Writing to be heard in FAAPI Conferences"** and led by our experts in the field **Raquel Lothringer** and **María**



Susana Ibáñez, with the support of Graciela Castelli and Claudia Naom. This had been a cherished project of the late president of FAAPI Daniel Fernández, who had planned it together with Raquel. But it wasn't until this year and the fact that the award provided the means that it could be launched. We used E-ducativa as a platform for the course and for this purpose some of us received training regarding technological aspects. Eleven participants of a heterogeneous background started the course; six of them fulfilled various of the activities allotted and four of them finished the course. The tutors pointed out that most of the participants' contributions, both in the forums as well as in the building of their portfolios, were of very good quality, though some of the attendees seemed to be affected by teaching workload.

We'd like to thank Raquel and Susana for their professional expertise, their open mind, their technological aptitude to design this very well planned online course. Last but not least, we are grateful to our dear colleague, FAAPI past President **Cristina Thomson**, who offered vignettes designed by her late husband, the dear strip cartoonist **Alfredo Grondona White**, which were used to illustrate and generate activities in the academic writing course.
